Suggested Language for Charitable Bequest:

"I hereby give, devise and bequeath to Lummi Island Congregational Church, a nonprofit charitable organization located in Whatcom County, WA, with Federal Tax ID number 13-1957221 ...

(the sum of \$____) OR (____ percent of my estate) OR (specific items of property) OR (all or \$____) of the rest, residue, and remainder of my estate

...as an unrestricted gift to be used at the discretion of its Council who may determine how best to apply such gift towards the work of the Lummi Island Congregational Church(or for specific purpose)."
